

Ameer Begum Welfare Trust believes in providing quality education to girls and to overcome the disparity existing between the education of boys and girls. (Thirty-two percent of primary school age girls are out of school in Pakistan, compared to 21 percent of boys) To remedy this inequality we must support and encourage the education of girls at every level and ensure barriers to their education are dealt with time.

Our Boongi Ram Singh High School is educating 200 girls from kindergarten to Class 9.

This is the only girls' high school in the area providing quality education and care. In August, ABWT team visited the school to distribute curriculum books as well as uniforms.

Two additional Water Filtration Plants were installed at Govt Girls Degree College Basirpur and Rural Health Center Basirpur which will benefit hundreds of students, patients and the general public on a daily basis. The filtration plants were donated by our esteemed donors Mr Farooq Akram and family and Sheikh Assad ur Rehman who additionally selected another site located at Jindran Kalan village for installation of new water filtration plants by the name of her beloved mother.




